When you consider the future do you tend to be more optimistic or pessimistic?

- What is the basis for your attitude toward the future?
- In the above passage and also Peters' later reflection in 1 Peter 1:3-9, why might the original hearers not be hopeful about the future for followers of Jesus?
- How do these passages show that the biblical notion of hope is more than wishful thinking?

What are some concrete ways that you have seen "the gates of Hades/hell" being assaulted as the Lord builds his church? (You might want to think in terms of the themes of this year's Vacation Bible School!)

Foundational to our participating in Jesus' work of building his church is making Peter's confession (verse 16) our own and living in light of it.

- What does Peter and this whole passage say or imply about who Jesus is?
- About what it means to follow him?
- What hinders people from making Peter's confession their own?
- How can these barriers be overcome?
