“Doing the Impossible”
Ephesians 3:20-21
Pastor Bill Hoffman

Context:

God is building his church and Paul wants to be part of it. (2:19-3:1).

Prayer for spiritual strength, depth, perspective, and fullness. (3:14-19).

3:20-21 text:

How much is God “able to do”?

Where does Paul say God’s power is “at work”?

What does “glory” mean, and where does Paul pray that this glory may be shown?

Application:

What evidence could you point to that shows God’s ability “to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine” in the physical universe? In history? In someone’s life?

Can you think of times in your own life when God has done a work like this?

How can someone more effectively access this power of God that Paul says is at work within followers of Jesus?
What can hinder someone from experiencing more of this power?

What are you longing for now that seems impossible apart from God’s powerful intervention?
