

**Sermon Notes – May 8, 2016**  
**“What Do You Think?”**  
**Psalm 15, Philippians 4:8-9**  
**Pastor Bill Hoffman**

Of the eight adjectives that Paul uses to describe what Christians are to think about (true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent, and praiseworthy), which ones come most easily to you and which ones are more difficult?

The word translated “think about” (logisthe) implies reflecting upon something in a way that it shapes the person’s conduct and character. Can you think of examples of how the ways you think impact your conduct and character?

**Verse 9:** This marks the second time in this brief letter that Paul has encouraged the Philippians to follow his example.

- Of what does Paul see himself as an example?
- Who has been a positive example of Christ-like thinking and character to you?
