**“Who Touched Me?”**  
**Luke 8:40-48**

What can be inferred from this passage about the woman’s status in the eyes of her community? In the eyes of Jesus?

“Daughter, your faith has healed you ...” (verse 48). What about this woman’s faith is commendable? What seems misguided or immature?

- Since Scripture has many examples of people of faith who are not healed or delivered from suffering (for example, Hebrews 11:35-40), it would be a mistake to universalize from this passage. What are your thoughts about the relationship between faith and healing or deliverance from other troubles?

After her healing, the woman probably wanted to slip away anonymously, but Jesus compels her to testify before the crowd about her healing. How might her faith and her life have been different had she not been “outed” by Jesus and compelled to testify?
