“Better Than Moses?”

Deuteronomy 18:14-18

Starting with their births, what are some similarities between Moses' and Jesus' lives and the ways they were used by God?

- See New Testament references to Deuteronomy 18:15 in Acts 3:22,23 and Acts 7:37. Also compare Deuteronomy 18:18 with John 8:28 and John 12:49.

While the Bible does not usually refer to either Moses or Jesus as prophets, in what ways can both be said to perform the role of prophet to God's people?

Seeing Jesus more clearly through Moses:

- Through Moses, Israel was delivered from slavery in Egypt. From what kind of slavery has Jesus delivered people? How was this deliverance accomplished?

Being set free from Egypt physically was not enough; the Israelites needed to be transformed from the habits and lifestyle of Egypt. How did God use Moses in this transformation? In what ways is this like, and in what ways different from how Jesus transforms people's lives and lifestyles today?
