**“Whom Can You Trust”**  
**Exodus 3:1-15**

What makes it easy — and not easy — to trust someone?  
What does the LORD say and do in this passage that indicates Moses can trust Him?

Doubt arises for Moses when the LORD tells him what he is to do (verse 11f.). To what extent do you see Moses doubting himself and to what extent is he doubting God?

After this incident, Moses still has reservations about trusting God (see thru Exodus 4:17). Besides the LORD's declaration that He is trustworthy, how does Moses learn that he can trust Him?

- How do we grow in learning that the God of the Bible is, indeed, someone in whom we can place our deepest trust?
