“Grace Alone”

1. How did the Pharisee feel about the tax collector? Why did the Pharisee think he was so good? Can we relate with this man's self-justification and pride?
2. What makes us right with God? What was the Pharisee trusting in for his right standing (righteousness) before God? Can we relate in any way with this type of thinking and attitude that the Pharisee had? How can we change this type of thinking and attitude in our own lives?
3. What was the tax collector trusting in for his right standing before God? Do we see our need for God's mercy if we are to be made right with God?
4. Who, in the end, does Jesus say is in a right relationship with God? If we are only made right with God on the basis of his mercy, how could this change the way we view and treat others?
