“Born Again”

John 3:1-17

Like Nicodemus, we may find it hard to understand reality that’s not physical. How might Jesus’ analogy of the wind (verse 8) help? What does the analogy of physical birth imply about what spiritual birth is like?

Verses 13-16. What does the “Son of Man” who is also God’s “one and only Son” have to do with being born again?
